

## EAA Chapter # 255 MEETING MINUTES of Sunday, NOVEMBER 13, 2016

### Call to Order:

- Will suspend meetings until the Spring. Christmas Party on Dec 4th next will suffice for our December meeting

- August 12<sup>th</sup> is the Veterans Day Event. Meetings to discuss will start in January
